GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL. (“**GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL**”, “**us**” or “**we**”) are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy, which includes any personal information that you may choose to provide us (“**Personal Information**”).

This privacy statement, together with GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL’s Terms and Conditions and Cookie Policy, sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL of 12 Woodsgate Park, Bexhill-on-Sea, TN394DL - Sussex (UK) and Via A. Vici, 20, 06034, Foligno Perugia (Italy) is the data controller in accordance with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We will process all Personal Information in accordance with GDPR.

The privacy of your personal data is important to us and we are wholly committed to ensuring that visitors to GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL’s website are informed about the information we may collect, the way we collect, use and store that information, and your rights at law with respect to that information.

This Statement sets out GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL’s privacy policies and practices for the personal information which you provide to us.

We may collect data about you including while you are navigating the pages of this website as well as details on how we use the information you provide to us and your rights in this regard.

By using this website you are subject to the terms of the statement.

We suggest that you take the time to familiarise yourself with its contents.

What happens when you visit GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's website?

Every time you connect to the internet or, if you use an always-on connection such as broadband or ADSL, you are automatically assigned a unique identifying number known as an Internet Protocol Address (“**IP Address**”). This IP Address, which contains information regarding the location of your computer on the internet, your country of origin and the name of your internet service provider (ISP), is automatically logged by GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL’s website.

When you visit a website, your web browser automatically downloads a copy of the web pages and pictures that you view to your hard disk. Certain pages of this website may also require that your browser downloads, together with the copy of the web page and pictures, a small text file called a “Cookie”.

We collect information from you when you fill out a form or where you are asked to provide details

If you subscribe to one of GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL’s newsletters or if you opt to fill in a form you will be asked to supply your email address and certain personal information such as your full name and surname, company, postal address, town, post code, country, telephone number and fax number. We store this information on GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL’s database in order to provide you with the requested service.

Why do we log your IP address?

What is an IP address?

When you first started your internet session (i.e. your computer connected to the internet) your computer was automatically assigned a unique: an IP Address. This is your computer’s unique address on the internet. Without that

IP Address, websites would not be able to deliver their content to you as they would not be able to find your computer on the internet.

Because each time you disconnect and reconnect to the internet a new IP Address is automatically assigned to your computer, IP Addresses are not suitable for us to identifying you as an individual.

How do we collect your IP Address?

Each time you visit a page within this website your computer sends out a message to GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's website asking for the content. This message sent by your computer also encloses your IP Address as a form of "return address" so that GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's website may find your computer on the internet in order to send it the requested content. GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's web-server automatically logs all these messages.

What do we do with your IP Address?

When we log your IP Address, the data collected is grouped up with the other logged IP addresses in order to provide us with statistics on visitors to the site, such as the geographic location of visitors, how long they stay on GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's site, which are the most viewed pages and other matters.

Collecting this information allows us to administer GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's site, diagnose potential server problems, analyse visitor trends and statistics, and generally helps us provide you with a better experience.

Cookies & Adwords

What are Cookies?

"Cookies" are small text files that are sent by websites so that the website can remember who you are. Without cookies, websites and their servers have no memory. A cookie, like a key, enables the website to remember users that have

already visited. Without a cookie, every time you open a new web page the server where that page is stored will treat you like a completely new visitor.

What are Adwords?

ADWORDS REMARKETING

This website uses the Google AdWords remarketing service to advertise on third party websites (including Google) to previous visitors to our site. It could mean that we advertise to previous visitors who haven't completed a task on our site, for example using the contact form to make an enquiry. This could be in the form of an advertisement on the Google search results page, or a site in the Google Display Network.

Third-party vendors, including Google, use cookies to serve ads based on someone's past visits to www.h7shelter.com website. Of course, any data collected will be used in accordance with our own privacy policy and Google's privacy policy. You can set preferences for how Google advertises to you using the Google Ad Preferences page, and you can even opt out of interest-based advertising entirely by permanently using a [browser plugin](#).

What do we do with the personal information you provide us with?

What do we use your personal information for?

Where contact details are submitted through the website or otherwise provided by you these are stored in GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL's contacts database primarily in order to be able to administer your request and to provide you with the information required. This can include:

1. For general account management and processing of your transactions via your banking service provider;
2. For the provision of services;

3. To help identify you in case we need to interact over the phone, electronic email or any other way;
4. To verify your age and accuracy of your registration details, including disclosure of such information to third parties e.g. financial institutions and third party reference agencies;
5. To serve appropriate and tailored marketing material and content via SMS, email, phone, push notification, post or otherwise, in accordance with your marketing preferences;
6. To help diagnose system problems and to administer our Website;
7. To gather broad demographic information about you, such as determining whether you are a user from outside the UK;
8. To monitor and improve our services;
9. To carry out customer research, testing and analysis;
10. To carry out risk management;
11. To enable us to comply with any legal or regulatory requirements; and
12. For advertising and promotional purposes.

We also store your personal data in order to be able to provide you with other information, from time to time, that we feel may be of interest or of use to you (including newsletters, mailshots, publications and other information) and generally for direct marketing and statistical purposes.

Countries outside the EEA do not always have strong data protection laws. We will ensure that each Group company and their service providers process your information under strict contractual instruction, in a secure manner and in accordance with this Statement.

Retention & Disposal

We keep your information for as long as is necessary for the purpose for which it was originally obtained. We will take all necessary steps to ensure that the privacy of information is maintained upon disposal.

Accessing and updating your personal information

You have the right to request a copy of the personal data that GIMME SHELTER GLOBAL holds about you and to have any inaccuracies corrected.
